

Travel

You are advised to prepare for your travels **at least two months in advance** to ensure that you have time to receive all the necessary inoculations etc.

It is very important that you seek advice at least 10 - 12 weeks before you travel. This is because some vaccinations need more than one injection, and others take time to start working.

### **IMPORTANT PATIENT INFORMATION**

#### CHANGES FROM 1<sup>ST</sup> APRIL 2016

Over the years it has been very difficult to provide parking for patients attending the practice. Patients will be aware that our old practice in Denmark Road had no patient parking. We were unfortunately unable to build a dedicated patient car park on this current site, and hence parking has always been a challenge for the practice to manage. As our signs clearly state – the car park has never been for patient parking.

Due to the increasing demands on the car park the practice has now decided to review the situation and take the following action. This action will ensure that we preserve a number of parking spaces for disabled patients, as well as providing parking spaces for our doctors and staff who are often in and out during the day (possibly on emergency calls). These changes will therefore ensure safety for patients and minimise disruption to practice staff. Please keep the drive to the car park clear at all times to ensure emergency access for ambulances.

From 1<sup>st</sup> April 2016, the doctors will be allocated a parking space along the front of the building. There are already allocated spaces for staff that work at the pharmacy and the building above them, and there will be practice staff parking at the end of the building.

There are two disabled parking spaces provided for frail, disabled and infirm patients which will be kept available at all times. It will still be possible to drop off patients at the practice or pharmacy.

There is road side parking in the area, but please be aware of the parking charges that now apply; and allow plenty of time for your appointment(s).

There are two car parks approximately 500 yards from the practice:-

The Triangle Car Park, in Russell Street and Magdalen Road Car Park – charges apply.
